## Minister of Health: After Vaccination, Covid-19 Cases in Health Workers Decreased

Health Minister Budi Gunadi Sadikin said, based on temporary data, there was a positive correlation between Covid-19 vaccination for health workers and the rate of transmission of the disease. According to Budi, the transmission of Covid-19 among health workers has decreased after vaccination was held. "The provisional data that we see, all health workers after being vaccinated have indeed decreased confirmed cases. We are still waiting for the data to be complete for definite conclusions," he said in a virtual press statement on YouTube of the Ministry of Health, Wednesday (17/2). Furthermore, Budi said, currently more than 1.1 million health workers have been injected with the first dose of the Covid-19 vaccine. Then, more than 500,000 health workers received the second dose of Covid-19 vaccination.

## Ministry of Health: 18 Million Doses of Covid-19 Vaccine Will Be Distributed for Vaccination Phase Two

Plt. Director General of Disease Prevention and Control at the Ministry of Health, Maxi Rein Rondonuwu, said that his party would distribute 18 million doses of vaccine to support the second phase of the Covid-19 vaccination program. He said, the 18 million doses of the Covid-19 vaccine will begin to be distributed in the early stages of 7.5 million doses of vaccine. "Then, nearly 11 million doses of vaccine in the first week of March," said Maxi in a virtual discussion, Wednesday (17/2/2021). Maxi said, along with the distribution of the Covid-19 vaccine produced by PT Bio Farma, the government is also waiting for 4.6 million doses of AstraZeneca vaccine from England. However, he said, AstraZeneca's Covid-19 vaccine was still waiting for data to be sent from the World Health Organization (WHO) to the Food and Drug Administration (BPOM).

## WHO Called New Cases of Covid-19 in the World Dropped by 16 Percent

The World Health Organization (WHO) reported that the number of new Covid-19 cases reported worldwide fell 16 percent last week to 2.7 million. The number of new deaths reported also fell 10 percent from the previous week to 81,000, according to the WHO in its latest weekly epidemiology report as quoted by ChannelNewsAsia.com, Wednesday (17/2/2021). Five of the six WHO work regions in the world reported double-digit percentage declines in new cases and only the Eastern Mediterranean saw an increase of seven percent. The number of new cases fell 20 percent last week in Africa and the Western Pacific, 18 percent in Europe, 16 percent in America and 13 percent in Southeast Asia. WHO Director General Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus said that the number of new cases had decreased for five weeks in a row or fell by almost half, from more than five million cases on January 4.
