

Manager Commentary

Central Bureau Statistics of Indonesia (BPS) announced Mar 2023 inflation at +0.18% mom (vs consensus inflation +0.28%, +0.16% in Feb 2023). On yearly basis, inflation was at +4.97% yoy (vs consensus inflation +5.12%, +5.47% in Feb 2023). Core inflation was printed at +2.94% yoy (vs consensus inflation +3.03%, +5.09% in Feb 2023). The lower inflation on or of volatile food group. The BI Board of Governors agreed on 15-16 Mar 2023 to hold the BI 7-Day Reverse Repo Rate at 5.75% and also hold the Deposit Facility (DF) and Lending Facility (LF) rates at 5.00% and 6.50%, respectively. In total, Bank Indonesia had increased their benchmark rate by 225bps up to Jan 2023. This decision for this policy is as front loaded, pre-emptive and forward-looking movement to lower the expectation inflation and to ensure the core inflation back to their target level at 3±1% on 1H 2023. Mr Perry Warjiyo mentioned that the latest rate hike was sufficient to bring the inflation back to their target. Rupiah appreciation against USD by +1.73% from 15,240 at end of February 2023 to 14,977 at end of March 2023. The appreciation of Rupiah was impacted by inflow of foreign investor from Indonesia's bond market and the FED start to slowing down hike FED's Fund Rate. Indonesia's trade balance recorded surplus amounting to USD +5,480mn in Feb 2023. Non-oil and gas trade balance in Feb 2023 recorded surplus USD +6,697mn, which was higher than the previous month that recorded trade surplus amounting to USD +5,289mn in Jan 2023. Meanwhile, oil and gas trade balance still recorded deficit to USD 1,220mn in Feb 2023, which was lower than the deficit in Jan 2023 amounting to USD 1,414mn. Indonesia's official reserve assets position amassed USD 145.2billion as of end March 2023, increased from USD 140.3billion as of end March 2023. The increment was impacted by the issuance of government foreign loan withdrawal as well as tax & service receipts.

In regards to our recent portfolio strategy, we maintain the portfolio mostly in deposits and would seek the opportunity to buy government bond and high rating corporate bonds with maturity under 1Y.
